Park Report:

- 4. Season receipts for the park will be around \$82,000.
- 5. Improvement projects completed this year: Bath house partition replaced, Bath house interior painted, Outhouse painted, fixed overhead lighting to remove wire hazard, 30 newly constructed picnic tables, new fire rings, purchased a new tractor with implements.
- 6. Commendations for the park staff on a fine job.
- 7. Year End Bonus **Motion** by Supervisor Blake-Thomas to pay a 10% of yearly compensation bonus to Crystal and Al. Second Trustee Loomis. Roll call vote: Supervisor Blake-Thomas "yes", Clerk Hillman "yes", Treasurer Boudreau "no", Trustee Loomis "yes", Trustee Simpson "yes". **Motion carried**.
